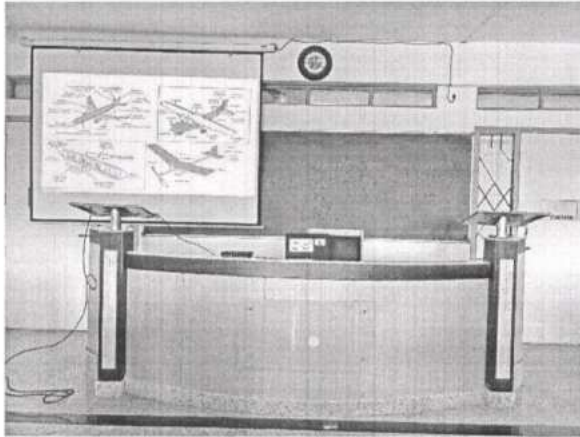
4. Practice

ICT tools in teaching and learning.

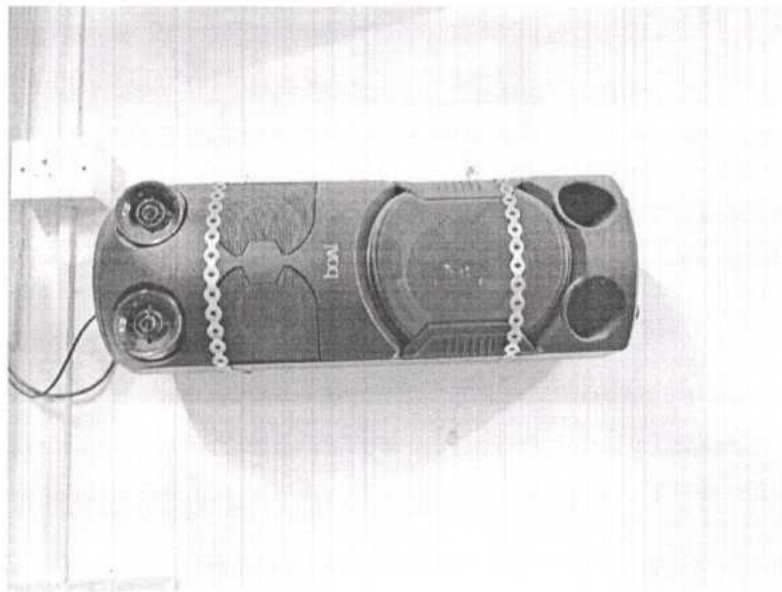
1. Digital projectors and displays:

All the 68 class rooms and 2 seminar halls are well equipped with the advanced projectors and display screen to make learning more interactive and engaging.



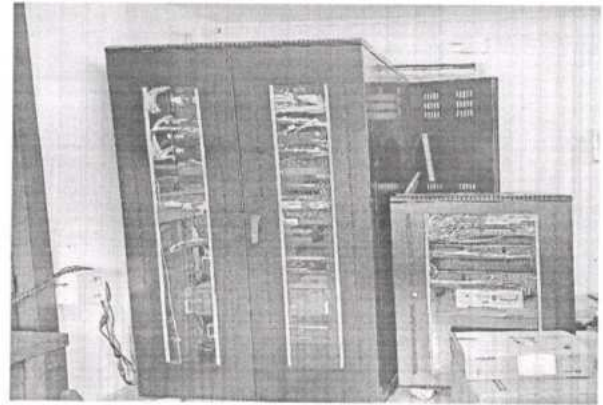
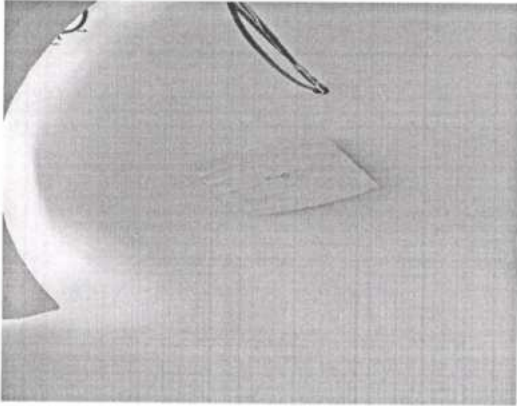
2. Audio-visual equipment (e.g., speakers, microphones)

LMS -Linways

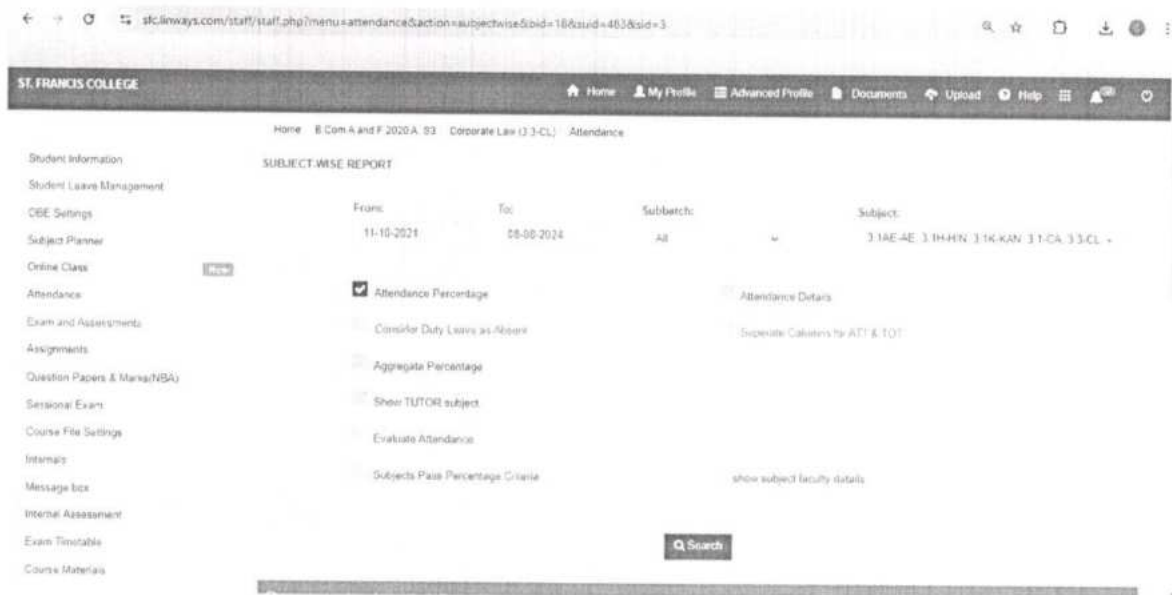
