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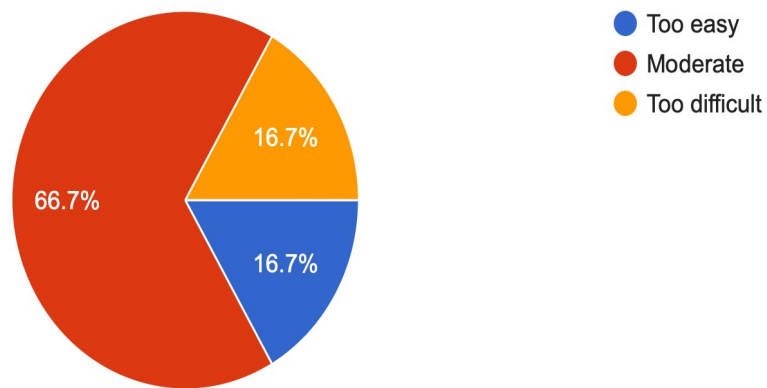

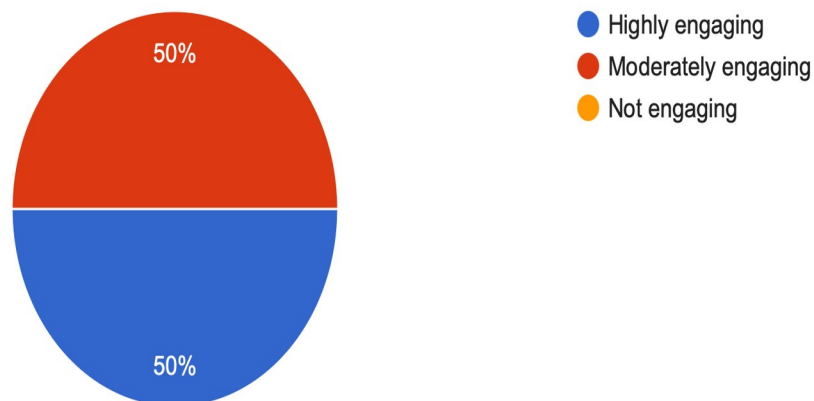
Was the level of difficulty of the riddles appropriate for the competition?

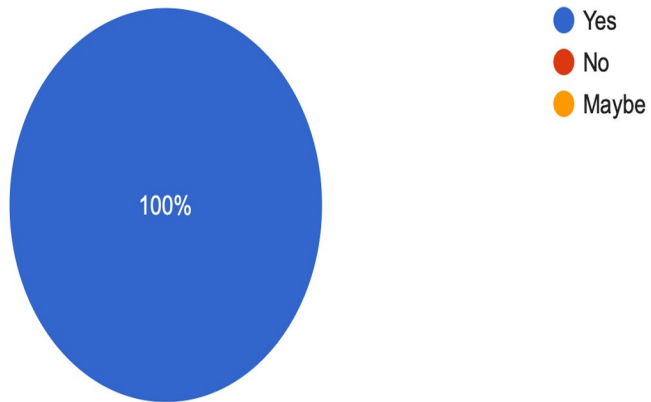
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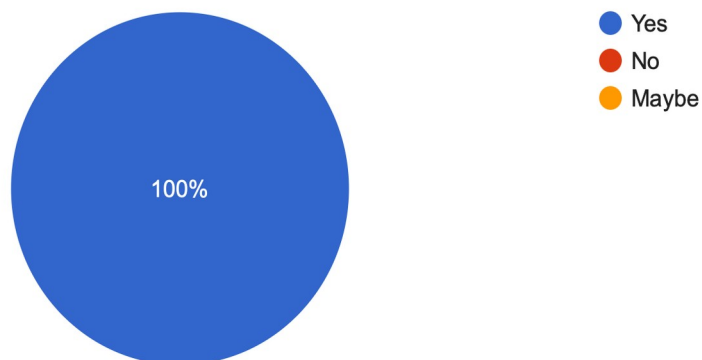
Did you find the time allotted for answering the riddles sufficient?

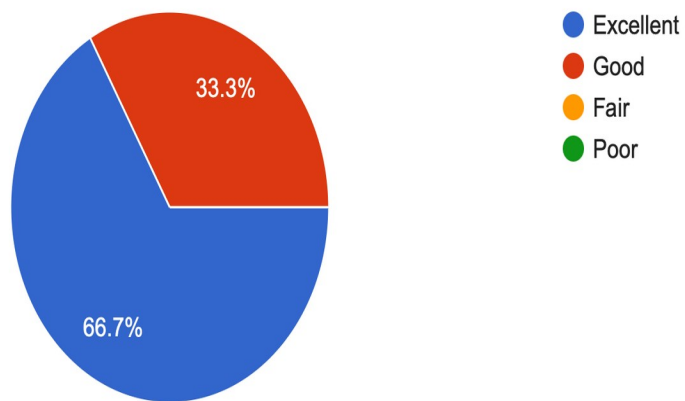
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How would you rate the overall organization of the riddle competition?
