Introduction

As part of the college's ongoing efforts to enhance the employability skills of students organized a **Guest Lecture followed by Mock Interviews** on **01.09.2025** at **6**th **floor seminar hall.** The program aimed to provide students with valuable insights from industry experts and to enhance their preparedness for campus placements through simulated interview experiences.

Objectives

- To create awareness about current industry expectations and career opportunities.
- To improve students' technical and communication skills through expert guidance.
- To boost confidence by engaging them in mock interviews simulating real placement scenarios.
- To bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements.

Guest Lecture Session

The session was conducted by Mr. Soumya Deep who was Vice president of J P Morgan Chase delivered an enlightening talk on Career Readiness and Emerging Industry Trends

Key highlights included:

- Importance of skill development in areas such as programming, data analytics, business communication, and problem-solving.
- Insights into upcoming career opportunities in domains like IT, Finance, Management, and Emerging Technologies.
- Practical advice on resume preparation, online assessments, and interview etiquette.
- Real-world industry examples to illustrate the expectations of recruiters.

The interactive session encouraged students to ask questions and clarify their career-related doubts.

Mock Interviews

Following the lecture, **mock interviews** were conducted by a panel of experts and faculty members. The process was designed to replicate actual campus recruitment procedures.

Format of Mock Interviews

- 1. **Technical/Domain Interviews** Students were evaluated on subject knowledge, problem-solving ability, and practical application of concepts.
- 2. **HR/Personal Interviews** Focus was on communication skills, confidence, body language, and overall personality.

The mock interview was conducted by two panels

Panel 1 includes Mr. Soumyadeep, who was VP, JP Morgan, alongside Subject matter expert, Mr. Prince and Placement Officer, Ms Harshita for MCA Students

Panel 2 includes Mr. Rakesh Founder of Strast, Subject matter expert Mr. Chintan Raj, and Placement officer Mr. Justin Raj for MBA students

Areas well performed

- 1. Body language of every student was professional
- 2. Tone of conversation was professional throughout the interview.

Areas of improvement

- 1. Self-introduction needs more attention
- 2. Knowledge of LinkedIn is limited
- 3. Lack of self-awareness in terms of strengths and weaknesses
- 4. Students lack self confidence
- 5. Lack of clarity of speech during conversation
- 6. On pressing students to speak more during the conversation, there were evident Mental roadblocks
- 7. Knowledge of current affairs is limited
- 8. Group discussion did not proceed in the direction of the topic asked by interviewer
- 9. Students did not carry pens and paper in the interview room

Outcome of the Program

- Students gained first-hand experience of placement interviews.
- The lecture and interviews helped identify individual strengths and weaknesses.
- Participants developed a better understanding of employer expectations.
- The program boosted confidence levels and motivated students to enhance their preparation.
