
About Conference

- All papers must be submitted in MS word 2010 and above
- Reference and Bibliography should be given in APA format

- Authors whose abstracts are selected will receive a confirmation email containing detailed payment instructions and the payment link.
- A registration fee of ₹700 is applicable only for abstracts that receive official confirmation. Upon selection, participants are required to submit their full paper to the same email address.
- All accepted papers will be published online and assigned both an ISSN and DOI.
- Please note: A maximum of two authors is permitted per paper, and an e-journal copy will be provided to both authors.
