7. Brief about the event:

The NCC Unit of St. Francis College, Koramangala, in association with St. Martha's Hospital, Parivarthanum Trust, and MAYA – The Reality Foundation, organised a **one-day Free Health Check-up Camp** on **28th November 2025** at St. Francis College. The camp aimed to provide accessible healthcare services to the staff of St. Francis institutions and the general public.

The camp was conducted from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and catered to both the staff of St. Francis institutions and the general public. A medical team comprising 15 members, including specialists from St. Martha's Hospital, carried out the health check-ups.

The tests conducted included blood pressure, blood sugar, ECG, and general medical consultations. Specialist consultations were available in Gynecology, Pediatrics, Orthopaedics, Cardiology, and General Medicine.

Over 250 participants availed themselves of the services and benefited from the camp by receiving insights into their health and medical status.
